

The EnVision2020 project, funded by the South-East Europe Programme, is aimed to develop significant steps in the sector of energy saving, renewable energy and sustainable mobility, in order to achieve the "20.20.20" goal (20% reduction in emissions of CO2, 20% increase in energy efficiency, diversification of energy sources with renewable energy by 20%) in SEE countries. The Envision2020 project is based on the assumption that the energy elasticity (the ratio between the change in energy consumption and the change in GDP) of the target cities can be changed based on forward-looking approaches, in particular by undertaking forecasting activities focused on the consumption of energy resources.

Demepa provided technical assistance to the Municipality of Potenza, one of the ten project partners coming from Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Germany, Italy, Romania and Slovenia.

The following tasks have been carried out:

- processing of data resulting from the survey carried out in the territory through questionnaires and interviews on emerging and applicable technologies in the field of energy efficiency and renewable sources,
- analysing the consumption of energy resources in the Municipality in view of the development and implementation of the energy strategy in the local energy plans,
- gathering information to identify political and economic barriers to be filled through appropriate policy recommendations,
- identification the key technologies essential to improve the efficiency of the consumption of energy resources in cities,
- review of the document "Compendium of best practices" prepared by the team leader Sofena,
- elaboration of the second project Newsletter,
- presentation of roadmaps and policy recommendations at the Mutual Learning Workshop held at the Municipality of Fermo.
